

Pinnacle Peak Estates III - Brush Removal Guidelines

- DO have your items out for pick up by 5:00 a.m. on Monday of the week your area is scheduled for collection.
- DO schedule your trimmings and clean ups to coincide with the brush removal schedule.
- DO, if you have street refuse collection, place your items adjacent to the curb in front of your property. Please be sure not to block the sidewalk with your material.
- DO, if you have alley refuse collection, place your items adjacent to your fence or property line in such a manner as to not block alley traffic or interfere with the collection of the 300 gallon refuse container.
- DO place your cuttings in a neat, bundled pile (up to 6 feet in length) and with all cut ends facing one direction.
- DO contain all small brush cuttings, grass clippings, leaves and palm skins in bags or boxes, and keep them separate from your brush pile.
- DO remember that each homeowner is responsible for the manner in which their material is placed out for collection, whether they hire someone else to do the work or not.
- DO, for everyone's safety, contain all cactus in covered boxes weighing 60 pounds or less each.

- DO NOT place construction waste, loose grass, remodeling materials, rocks, loose leaves or twigs, dirt, loose refuse or unboxed/uncovered cactus out for collection. Our crews can not collect these items.
- DO NOT mix trash, rocks, dirt, wire, cactus, grass, bricks, cement or other materials in with your brush as our crews will be unable to collect it until these items are removed.
- DO NOT place material more than 6 feet onto your property or behind your fence as our crews may be unable to collect it.
- DO NOT place your items out for collection more than one week prior to the week your area is scheduled for collection.
